Word Problems

Q1) Tom has 5 storybooks. He gets 1 more book as a gift. How many storybooks does Tom have now?

$$\underline{5} + \underline{1} = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ storybooks}$$

Q2) Lucy has 2 marbles. She finds 3 more marbles in the playground. How many marbles does Lucy have in total?

Q3) There are 2 trays of cookies. Each tray has 3 cookies. How many cookies are there in total?
